Dear Reader,

Welcome to the **Miami-Dade County Homeless Trust's Directory of Services**. The Trust has created this Directory to assist those who have found themselves homeless, and oftentimes, helpless. It's full of service providers who are experienced working with individuals experiencing homelessness – and even those who are about to be homeless.

But before you use the guide, make sure the first call that's made is to our Helpline at **1 (877) 994-4357**. Get registered! When you call, choose a language, then follow these prompts:

**Press 1** if you are experiencing domestic violence

**Press 2** if you are veteran

**Press 3** if you are facing a court eviction or are at risk of becoming homeless

**Press 4** if you are looking for indoor feeding locations

**Press 5** if you are looking for indoor showers

**Press 6** if you are homeless on Miami Beach

**Press 7** if you are homeless in any other area of Miami

**Press 8** if you are in need of affordable housing options

After calling the Helpline and reviewing this document, if you still have questions about services in Miami-Dade, you can also reach out to **3-1-1** or call the Consumer Hotline at **888-248-3111** for questions about mental health, substance abuse, or community services.
